

POLICY GOVERNING THE USE OF "BIG TOYS" AT MBC

The "Big Toys" were purchased by MBC as an avenue to reach our community in an innovative way. To that end, their use must always *be* outreach-based, and not with the intention of incurring a profit.

All persons / groups requesting to use the Big Toys should adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Bookings must be approved by the Pastor/Leader tasked with oversight of the units.
2. The Big Toys should be set up/taken down only under the direction of persons who have been approved to do so by the Pastor/Leader tasked with oversight of the units. Currently those persons are Mark Procopio and Pastor Scott Wolf.
3. Persons/Groups wishing to use the Big Toys must provide their own staffing per the following guidelines:

Big Slide (minimum 2 persons):

- 1 person stationed at the top of the slide to ensure that participants do not jump on the upper platform, and to ensure that said participants go down the slide in a safe and proper manner. (feet first, no jumping and safely spaced)
- 1 person stationed at the entrance to the slide to ensure that proper attire is worn (no shoes, jewelry, watches or sharp belt buckles), and to regulate the numbers of persons using the slide at one time.

Obstacle Course (minimum 2 persons):

- 1 person stationed at the top of the wall to ensure that participants go down the slide in a safe and proper manner. (feet first, no jumping and safely spaced)
- 1 person stationed at the entrance to the course to ensure that proper attire is worn (no shoes, jewelry, watches or sharp belt buckles), and to regulate the numbers of persons using the course at one time.
- **Please limit the number of children on the obstacle course to no more than 2-3 children on it at one time. No jumping is allowed in the area at the bottom of the climbing wall.** Too much jumping in this area has caused the area to rip. Please be careful with the toy so that everyone can continue to enjoy it.

In addition, a minimum of 3 persons should be provided to assist in the set-up and removal of the units.

4. The Big Toys will be available at no charge to all ministries at MBC. Members/Adherents wishing to use the toys for personal use (birthday party, other celebration) should be charged a maintenance fee per the facility use schedule.

5. The Big Toys shall be used on MBC property at all times.
6. As a general rule, persons/groups using the units should adhere to the following guidelines:
 - No Food or Drink on the units
 - Proper attire required (no shoes, jewelry, watches or sharp belt buckles)
Socks are recommended, if possible.
 - The units are to be used as intended. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all persons using the units, no excessive or unruly horseplay will be allowed.
